PROGRAM VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AT THE CENTER:

_____ Teen Group - "*Dream Teens*" is a monthly peer support group for teenagers with cancer or a chronic blood disorder. Volunteers are needed to chaperone events.
Time requirement: Meets once a month and we use volunteers as needed to chaperone. You would not be required to go every month.

_____ Mr. McDaniel's Classroom - tutoring program for sickle cell patients in grades K-6. Held every Tuesday night during the school year from 6:00-8:00pm. Tutors are assigned to work with the same child each week. After dinner, kids spend one-on-one time with their tutor. At 7:30 we get together for a group activity.
Time requirement: We prefer that tutors commit for the school year.

_____ Family Fun Days - a recreational support program that provides an opportunity for families to share their experiences in an environment different from the traditional support group. Volunteers are needed to set up, supervise and assist with cleanup of the event.
Time Requirement: Events are held three times a year. You would not be required to help with every event.

_____ Holiday Adopt A Family - a program designed to assist families during the holidays. Volunteers are needed to sort donated items, coordinate deliveries and pick up of items.
Time Requirement: This event is held during the month of December.

_____ Oncology Support Group - a program for parents, grandparents and family members who have a child diagnosed with cancer. This group meets at the center on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month from 6:00-9:00pm. Volunteers are needed to do crafts and activities with the kids while the adults meet.
Time Requirement: You are not required to help twice a month. Once a month or once every other month would be helpful.

_____ Lil' Tales - a playgroup program for pre-school aged children who have cancer or a chronic blood disorder. This group meets every Tuesday morning from 10:00am until noon. Volunteers are needed to do crafts and activities with the kids while the adults meet.
Time Requirement: You are not required to help every week.

_____ Bereavement Support Group - a program for family members who have lost a child to cancer. This group meets at the last Monday of the month from 6:00-8:00pm. Volunteers are needed for crafts and activities with the kids while the adults meet.
Time Requirement: You are not required to help each month.

Parent's Day or Night Out - a program to give respite care for the parents. This program is held approximately three times a year. Volunteers are needed to help with set up, doing activities and crafts with the kids and clean up.

Time Requirement: This event is held throughout the year (in the fall before school starts, during the Holiday Season and one other time TBA).

Mom's Spa Day - a program to provide respite care for the mothers who have children currently on treatment. Volunteers are needed to help with set up, doing activities and crafts with the kids and clean up.

Time Requirement: Once a year.

Summer Camp Programs - Kite Camp and Kanga Camp-these programs meet for one week (during the day) in the summer. Kite Camp is usually held in June and Kanga Camp is usually held in July. Volunteers are needed to help supervise the kids during camp, clean up, etc.

Time Requirement: Can work all week or just one or two days.

FUNDRAISING AND CLERICAL ASSISTANCE

Fundraising Events - Various fundraisers occur during the year. The Center holds Golf Tournaments, Fashion Shows, Fishing Tournaments and other events that require volunteer assistance.

Time Requirement: Volunteers are notified via e-mail or through the mail about upcoming events and volunteer based on their availability.

Holiday Card Project - The card project is the single largest fundraiser for the Center. Volunteers are needed to assemble card orders and prepare them for at the center. Volunteers are also needed to help sell cards at craft shows.

Time Requirement: Daily during the months of November and December. You can sign up to work when your schedule allows; once a week etc.

Publix Holiday Card Project - Cards are sold in all Publix stores in Hillsborough, Pinellas and Pasco counties. Volunteers are needed to adopt stores and be responsible for setting up and keeping the cards stocked in the stores of their choosing.

Time Requirement: Volunteers are needed November through December. Must be willing to check their stores weekly to keep them well stocked and pick up all unsold cards by the third week of December.

Clerical Assistance - Volunteers are needed on occasion to help with stuffing envelopes, filing and other office duties at the Center.

Time Requirement: Days and hours can be arranged to fit your schedule.
